Kay Loraine Barnes Clayton went to sleep in Jesus on Saturday, October 24, 2009 after her courageous 3 year battle with brain cancer. Kay was born in San Antonio, Texas on December 5, 1941 – the first born and daughter of beloved parents, Bonnie and John Barnes who have preceded her in death. Kay married her high school sweetheart, William "Bill" Travis Clayton, Jr. on January 15, 1960 and lived with him happily in their retirement home in Leakey, Texas. She is survived by Bill, her two sons, daughter-in-law and five grandchildren.
