Keith Roger Bostow went to be with the Lord on May 23, 2011 in Bandera, Texas. He was born on October 12, 1952 in San Antonio, Texas. Keith was retired Army and served his country as a Green Beret in the Special Forces during the Vietnam War. He was a double for James Garner in the movie Streets of Laredo and was one of the Texas Rangers in the movie Dead Man's Walk, both of which were filmed in West Texas. Keith represented the Audie Murphy VA for many years in the Disabled Veterans Winter Sports Clinic and the National Veterans Wheelchair Games winning numerous medals and always brought home the gold in swimming events. He also represented San Antonio for many years on the Wheelchair Spurs team. For more than 25 years Keith was an avid supporter of the San Antonio Conservation Society during NIOSA by serving as a volunteer Cascarone Booth Co-Chairman in Frontier Town, Area Assistant Chairman in Clown Alley and Arneson Theatre, and Area Chairman in International Walkway. Keith lived life to the fullest and thoroughly enjoyed his time on the Bostow Ranch Resort in Bandera, Texas. His family and friends were blessed to have him as a part of their lives. He was preceded in death by his father, Paul L. Bostow; son, Keith Bostow, Jr.; and brother, David Bostow. Keith is survived by his mother, Florence Bostow; his loving wife of 22 years, Deanna Bostow; daughter, Valerie Bostow; sons, Jonathan Simons Christina, Beau Simons; sisters, Brenda Petty, Karen Bostow, Lisa Coles Ernie; brother, Paul Bostow; grandchildren, Joseph
