LTC Kelton D. Miller USAF Ret. passed peacefully from this life on August 5th. He was stationed in Germany all of 1946, where he realized his dream of flying jets. Retiring from the Army Air Corps in 1947, Kelton then served in the USAF Reserve until 1980. He was involved with flying as long as he was physically able.
