



Kenneth L. Evers

December 21, 1930 - December 22, 2017

Kenneth L. Evers, son, husband, father, grandfather, uncle, cousin, and friend went home to be with his Lord on December 22, 2017, one day after his 87th birthday. Kenneth was born to Ella Grote Evers and Christian Clyde Evers at home on Evers Road on December 21, 1930. Kenneth was baptized and confirmed at Zion Lutheran Church of Helotes. Graduating from Thomas Jefferson High School in 1948, he started his dairy business that summer with Lester Krueger. They continued as partners for several years before going their separate ways. On December 14, 1950, he married the love of his life, Virginia Wilson, and they faithfully remained united for 65 years until her death in 2016. Kenneth and Virginia had a large Holstein dairy for 35 years! First located on Evers Road, then on Babcock Road and finally in Bulverde, Texas. They sold their dairy in 1983 and Kenneth enjoyed only “partial” retirement since he always had cattle, goats, and sheep on his property. In addition to being an expert dairyman, Kenneth was a welder, inventor, fisherman, hunter, sausage maker, gardener, and lawn-mower extraordinaire. Kenneth loved to fish, mostly at the Texas coast, and hunt, especially in the lower country of Texas, and he had several champion deer heads mounted showing his pride. Kenneth and Virginia were blessed with 2 daughters, Susan (husband Allen Pierce) of San Antonio, and Denise (husband R. Doug Davis) of Georgetown, Texas, and one grandson, Kyle Davis (wife Maggie King) of Dallas, Texas. The family wishes to acknowledge the loving care and friendship Kenneth received from his caregivers Mary, Aleyda, Elfida, and Brandy, from his

nephews and niece, Frank Alderson, Ervin and Elaine Wegner, family and friends (you know who you are!) and from his Hospice Nurse, Liz and her skilled support team at River City Hospice.

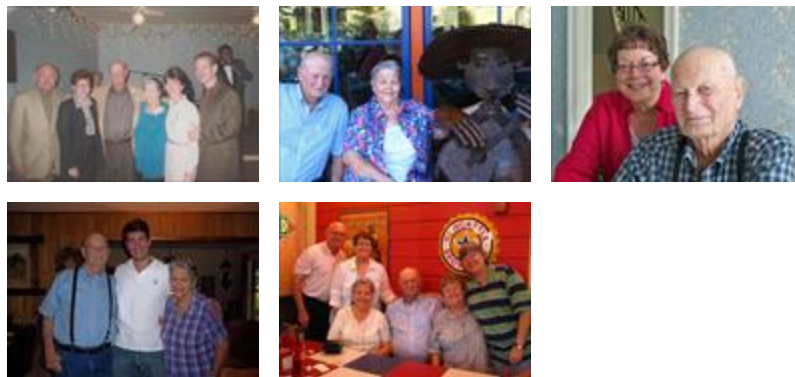
