



Kenneth G. Johnsen

June 10, 1920 - May 21, 2005

Mr. Kenneth G. Johnsen, age 84, was born on June 10, 1920 in Echo, Minnesota to Melius and Alice Johnsen, and passed away on May 21, 2005 in San Antonio. Mr. Johnsen lived in Green Bay, WI. He enlisted in the Army Air Corp in August 1940 and served in India during WWII. He married Mary Linda Gill in Dilley, Texas on June 10, 1944. He received his BBA from the University of Texas in 1949. He had a long career in the insurance business. He worked for the State of Texas, Continental Insurance, USAA and San Antonio Bank and Trust. At the time of his death he was affiliated with AFLAC. He was a member of the Masonic Holland Lodge #1 of Houston, TX. He was a longtime member of the Coker Methodist Church.
