Lt.Col. Lamar C. Jim Harrier, USAF-Ret., age 68, died at home on March 26, 2011, from heart failure. He was born in Charleston, SC, on October 28, 1942, and graduated from St. Andrews High School of Charleston and the University of South Carolina.

An avid sportsman, Jim was a high school all-American quarterback and played football for the University of South Carolina. In the Air Force for 20 years, Jim served as an Intelligence Officer specializing in directing covert intelligence operations against the Soviet Union during the Cold War era. After retiring from the Air Force, Jim obtained degrees in counseling and worked as a psychotherapist.

Jim is survived by his wife, Brenda; former wife, Ginger Harrier; son Mark and wife, Anna; daughter Natasha Reagan and husband, Robert; and three grandchildren, Brandon, Trinity and Brodie. Special thanks go to his loving caregiver of two years, Ilda Hilda Menchaca.
