Landa Lee Mabry passed away peacefully on February 12, 2024 at the age of 74.

Born on July 19, 1949 in Ft. Worth, TX, Landa was the daughter of Dr. Warren and Wanda Hultgren. She grew up in Corpus Christi TX, Lake Charles, LA and Tulsa, OK alongside her brothers Warren Jr. and Howard. Landa attended Baylor University where she met the love of her life, Bob Mabry, whom she was married to for 53 years.

Together they raised their two sons Matt and Clint in San Antonio, TX. Landa was a devoted mother, always putting her family ahead of herself and instilling in her children the loving, compassionate Christian values she was taught from her parents.

Landa and Bob were affectionally known as "Lolli and Pops" by their three grandchildren Larson (16), Austin (13), and Sawyer (9) whom she cherished deeply. From suitcases full of gifts for the grandchildren when visiting them, baking birthday cakes for Jesus at Christmas when they were young, to making her mother's legendary ice cream balls and playing competitive family games of Wahoo, Lolli's love for her grandchildren knew no bounds.

Landa had a unique gift of establishing a meaningful connection with the people in her life, placing their needs before hers and always making them feel special. She inspired those around her to live, laugh and love, leaving an indelible impact and legacy of kindness, compassion and generosity. Her attributes were most prevalent as a founding member of the "Queens of Fun" social group who spread laughter, cheer and charity wherever they went for two decades.

Landa will be remembered for her Christian faith, sense of humor, joy of being the life of the party, loyalty and those beautiful big blue eyes like none other.

Landa is preceded in death by her parents Pastor Emeritus Warren Curtis Hultgren (First Baptist Tulsa), Wanda Lee Wadsworth Hultgren, and her son Matthew Curtis Mabry.
