Lanier C. Harris, Jr., born on April 2, 1918 in Little Rock, Arkansas, went to be with the Lord on May 5, 2006 in San Antonio, Texas. He obtained an Electrical Engineering Degree from Texas A&M University. Lanier served in the U.S. Army Signal Corp under General Patton during the Normandy invasion and the Battle of the Bulge and was awarded the Bronze Star during this campaign. He was a manager for S.H. Kress & Co. for 25 years and the owner of Naomi's Gift Shop for 22 years. Lanier was preceded in death by his loving wife, Rose Sobrino Harris; and brother, Joe Harris. He is survived by his daughter, Roseann Azar of Houston, TX; son, John Harris and wife, Anne of San Antonio, TX; sister, Virginia Beare of Blanco, TX; son-in-law, Richard Azar of Houston, TX; grandchildren, Rebecca Mulvaney, Amanda Harris and Steven Azar.
