



## Larry David Johnson

January 30, 1950 - September 19, 2020

On Saturday, September 19th, 2020, Larry David Johnson, much loved husband, father, and grandfather, passed away with his wife Elenor by his side after battling several health issues over the last few years. He was 70.

Larry was born January 30th, 1950 in Joliet, IL. He is preceded in death by his parents Erma (nee Ludtke) and Erwin Johnson and his older sister Judy.

Growing up in Joliet, Judy and he were raised entirely by their mother in a single parent household during the 1950s and 60s, as their father left before he was born. He worked and started a family there, before relocating to San Antonio in 1985 after a divorce. On April 24th, 2004 he married Elenor Sanchez. Over the last eight years they have been raising, and eventually adopted, her grandchildren Xavier, Drake, and Gary.

He loved motorcycles and boating and spent the majority of his weekends on the water at Canyon Lake. Always able to light up a room, he was the life of the party. In the final weeks of his life, as he knew his time was approaching he stated at he felt bad for anyone he hurt in the past, but had no regrets in his life.

He is survived by his wife Elenor (nee Sanchez); his children Cristine, Vincent, and Victoria; Elenor's children Christina, Gary and Nicole; their three adopted

children Xavier, Drake, and Gary; and 9 grandchildren, 3 great-grandchildren.
