Lawrence D. Coindreau, age 70, passed away on Monday November 19th 2018. A U.S. Marine Corp. Veteran, Larry was injured serving in the Vietnam War. He was the Operational Manager at Levitz Furniture and after suffering a life altering accident in 1988 became a quadriplegic on a ventilator for the remaining 30 years of his life. Larry went back to school to earn his degree in computer science continuing on to work for the Texas Rehabilitation Commission in Austin until his retirement. Larry was an avid hunter, and champion marksman. He was a strong, generous man, loving husband and father. Larry is survived by his loving wife Mary Coindreau and daughter Melissa Coindreau; brothers, Charles Coindreau, Stephen Coindreau and wife Michel, Ronnie Coindreau and wife Luanna, Andy Coindreau and wife Laura, Alan Coindreau and wife Patricia; sister, Phyllis Patterson and husband Bruce; nieces, nephews and extended family.
