Lee Ernest Blue was born in Meridian, Mississippi, on December 16, 1913, and passed away on February 20, 2009 at age 95. Lee joined the National Guard at the age of 18 and served honorably during WWII in Africa and Italy. He retired from the U.S. Army as a Major in 1952 and from the U.S. Foreign Services in 1973. His curious sense of humor and gentle nature endeared him to everyone who met him. He is survived by his loving wife Sonja Blue and their four children: daughter Silvia Frost and husband Mark; daughter Teresa Guerra and husband Frank; son Alex Blue and wife Sherry; daughter Dina Post and husband Frank.
