



Lee Earl Day

Lee Earl Day, 94, of Fort Worth, formerly of San Antonio, died Friday, February 8, 2019 in Fort Worth. Graveside services will be held Thursday, February 14th at Mission Park Cemetery in San Antonio.

Lee and his twin brother, Henry were both April 13, 1924 to Henry Lee Day and Pearl (Wilkerson) Day in Devol, Oklahoma. He grew up in the Burkburnett area. After the death of his mother, he spent much of his childhood happily living with his grandparents on their farm. When Lee turned 18, World War II was in progress and he enlisted in the Army Air Corp. He served in the Quartermaster Corp in the Pacific Theatre.

After the War, Lee spent the majority of his career as a service station owner. He met and married his beloved wife Delores in 1957. They spent many happy years working together both at their service station and at the ranch they owned in Seguin. They were married almost 60 years. Lee loved the outdoors and was an avid walker for many years.

Lee was preceded in death by his wife, Delores, and sisters, Inez Day Elliott and Marcella Day Coleman. He is survived by his brother Henry Day and a number of nieces and nephews.
