MSGT Leopoldo Dimando, US Army RET, passed away on February 19, 2015 at the age of 76. Mr. Dimando was born November 30, 1938 in San Antonio, Texas. He entered his military service in the U.S. Marine Corps and transferred into the U.S. Army as a Paratrooper with the 101st and 173rd Airborne Division, and served honorably until retirement after 22 years. He was awarded several medals to include the Bronze Star with V for Valor. He later retired with close to 22 years with Brady Clinic the University of Texas Health Systems as Central Appointments Manager. Mr. Dimando was a life member of VFW Post 76 and member of the Alamo Silver Wings.
