He devoted a lifetime towards the Boy Scouts of America, first as a Boy Scout, then later as a Scoutmaster for his son David and later as assistant Scoutmaster for his grandson Robert. He was a member of the Order of the Arrow which later sparked his interest in Native American culture. This inspired him to become a member of the Texas Indian Heritage Association (TIHA) and the United San Antonio Pow Wow which he shared with his daughter Jennifer who was named as Princess in 2001. After his retirement, he continued his work with arts and crafts and was a prominent vendor at the King William Fair, Starving Artist Show and was even the featured artist at the Huffhines Art Trails show in Richardson, Texas. He also enjoyed his time as a member of the San Antonio Potters Guild and taking classes at the Southwest School of Art. LeRoy was a devoted husband to his wife, Linda for 54 years and will always be remembered as a amazing father, grandfather, son, brother, and friend.

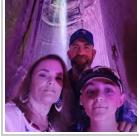
