L.D. Taylor joined the heavenly angels on Christmas Eve after a long battle with ALS. He was born August 18, 1950 to George Taylor and Dawn Warren Taylor in San Antonio, Tx. He was a great son, husband, father, grandfather, uncle, brother and friend, and lived life to the fullest. He was a member of Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church in Helotes and served on the ACTS retreat with his fellow brothers. Don was inspirational in spreading the gospel. He graduated from John Marshall High School in 1968 and was in the band and Distributive Education. In 1970, Don married Patty Potter, his loving wife of 37 years. He was a policeman for over 30 years, starting in Live Oak and Balcones Heights, eventually becoming the Chief of Police in Grey Forest, TX. In 1982, Don started Taylor Made Hose with his dad helping it to become the successful business it is today. He served as PTA President, was a part of Project Graduation and Spirit Committee for his children's schools. He was one of the founding fathers of Ram Bozos. Don is preceded in death by his dad, George Taylor. He is survived by his wife, Patty; son, Jeff Taylor and wife Paige; daughter, Leslie Austin and husband Conner, all of San Antonio; his mother Dawn Taylor of Burnet, TX; brother Warren Taylor and wife Ruby of New Bern, NC; Potter Brothers: Tom and wife Janice, Gerald and wife Amy and Mark; sister Karen Pierce; his legacy grandson, Dalton James Taylor and his grand dogs, Hana and Cocoa.
