Lewis E. Matteson, 88, native of Ohio, expired at 12:47 a.m. Good Friday, March 21, 2008, after an energetic life and brief, severe illness. He joined his wife Audrey Moates Matteson, who had preceded him in death ten years before. A forty-year resident of San Antonio, Matteson was, at the time of his death, an active and beloved deacon of Oakridge Baptist Church.
