Lewis Elmo Quinn Jr. died on August 13, 2013 at age 88 while being cared for in Boerne, Texas. He was born on October 25, 1924 in Austwell to Lewis E. Quinn and Rosa Roell Quinn. After graduating from Woodsboro HS, he trained as a part of the National Youth Administration of Texas during WWII.
