Libbie Hruza Brezacek, a longtime Omaha resident, and currently of San Antonio, TX, died on August 13, 2009. Libbie was born on August 29, 1921, in Czechoslovakia. She came to the USA with her parents in 1923, and they settled in Omaha. Libbie spent several years as manager of the Omaha City Employees Credit Union. In 2003, she and her husband moved to San Antonio to be near her older daughter and family.
