Librado "Leroy" Garcia went to be with the Lord on Wednesday, March 8, 2023, at the age of 71. He is preceded in death by his parents, Johnnie C. Garcia, and Socorro S. Garcia; brother, Johnny S. Garcia; sister, Rosemary Lozano. Leroy is survived by his loving wife Mary Morlett Garcia; brothers Armando (Lupe), Eddie (Corine), sister-in-law, Frances Garcia, brother-in-law, Daniel Lozano, Sr., his "hermanita" Terri Smith (Wesley), his Dachshund and best friend Mario, along with numerous nieces, nephews, and godchildren.

Born and raised in San Antonio, Texas, Leroy was a graduate of Sidney Lanier High School, where he played the trumpet as a member of the Mighty Voks Marching Band and continued as a member of the Sensational Seventies Alumni group. As an employee of the City of San Antonio, Leroy worked for 32 years as a machinist in the Purchasing & General Services Department. He volunteered much of his time working with various groups and organizations, including The Jaycee's and Knights of Columbus, where he earned his 4th Degree Knighthood. Leroy was an active member at Our Lady of Perpetual Help, having served as a sacristan, lector, Eucharistic Minister, member of the choir and served as the first male president of The Guadalupanas.

Leroy was a loving husband, calling Mary his “Princess” and “the love of his life.” He cherished his family deeply and is remembered as a caring and humble man, someone who was incredibly passionate about his family. He could always be counted on for a good joke or even a good story. He kept God at the center of his life but was also never afraid to “tell it like it is.” Leroy loved life, he loved to laugh, and he truly loved his family. He leaves behind numerous family members, extended-family and countless friends. He will be deeply missed by all who knew him.
