



## Lillian D. Mowat

May 14, 1922 - December 1, 2021

It is with great sadness that we report that our family's matriarch, Lillian D. Mowat, also known as "Randi" to friends, "Mom" to her children and "Nanny" to most everyone else, died at the age of ninety-nine (99) on Wednesday, December 1, 2021 in San Antonio, Texas. 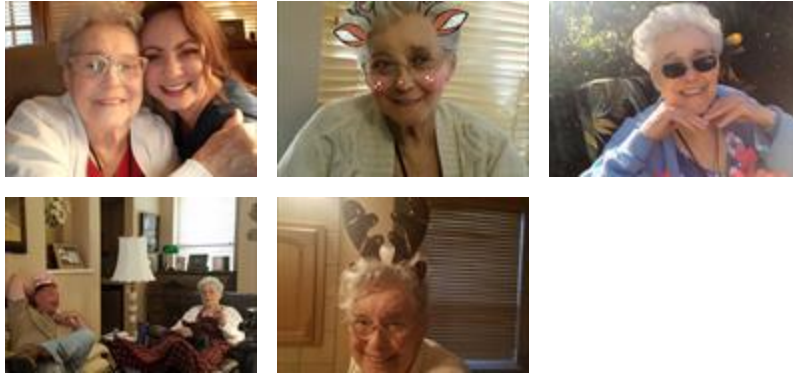

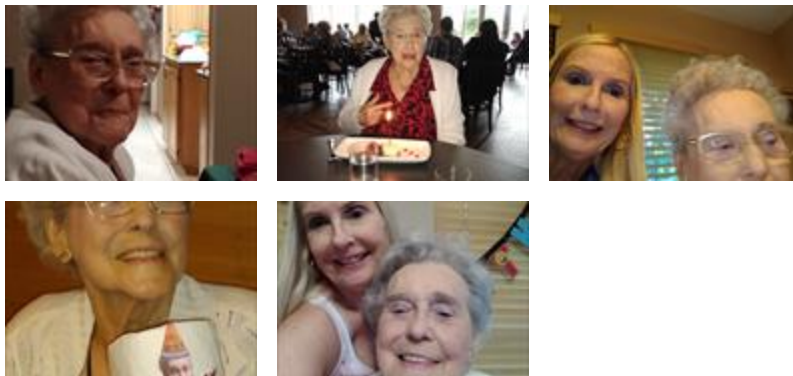

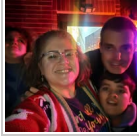
