The two were wed on August 24, 1968. Jaime entered the Army and was sent to Germany. Linda joined him and the two started their life together in Germany. After his service was completed they returned to San Antonio and began building a life together. They were active members of St. Paul's Catholic Church and eventually became owners of University Printers. They raised two children (Linda and Jaime – yes there are two Lindas and two Jaimes.)

Their family grew to welcome a son-in-law (John) and daughter-in-law (Marcy) and four grandchildren (John Paul, Victoria, Lilly and MAC) – all of whom they loved dearly. Linda preceded Jaime in retirement and devoted herself to her local church – St. Brigid's Catholic Church. Linda "encouraged" Jaime to volunteer as well and the two could be found assisting Saint Vincent De Paul as well as traveling and spending time with their grandkids.

Linda is preceded in death by her parents Bruno and Jean Vera. Linda is survived by her devoted husband Jaime, her daughter Linda (John) and son Jaime (Marcy); four grandchildren John Paul, Victoria, Lilly and MAC. 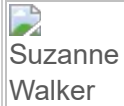
