Linda Ramirez Larson, a beloved wife, mother, grandmother, sister, and friend to all, known by many as “Gramsie”, passed away in her home in San Antonio, Texas surrounded by her family on November 9, 2022 at age 86. She was and always will be so very loved by all her family and friends. Linda had a genuine, joyous, kind and loving personality that drew everyone she knew close to her.

Born the 3rd of 6 children to Luciano Ramirez and Socorro Sapinoso in Cavite City, Philippines, she was always described as a dependable and caring sister whom they often leaned on throughout their lives.

After graduating with a Bachelor of Science & Masters in Business Administration with focus in Finance & Banking from the University of the East in Manila, Philippines, she pursued her dreams of working for a large successful U.S. corporation, Brown & Root Inc. in South Vietnam, where she excelled for many years and accomplished so much. There she met her husband, Herman Don Larson, where they fell in love and later moved to Houston to raise their only daughter, Erika.

Later in life, Linda worked for the U.S. Department of Defense as an Investigator, DOW Chemical USA, as well as, Texas A&M University System. She was also fluent in 4 languages and traveled to over 8 countries. In her
