Bill was born to Emmet and Nellie Willis on May 26th 1947 in Quincy, IL. Raised on a small rural farm with his sister Eunice and survived by his brother Carl. Bill graduated from Payson High school as Valedictorian. He received degree in Mathematics from Western Illinois University with Honors. Bill started work as a civilian in the U.S. Air Force as an instructor. He was stationed at Chanute A.F.B. in Rantoul, IL. Bill eventually retired after 37 years of service as a GS-15 at Randolph A.F.B. TX and was the Chief of Interservice Programs Training. Linda was born to Fred and Delores Smith on November 3rd 1949 in Macomb, IL. She is survived by her brother Fred and sister Jana. She graduated from Bushnell-Prairie City High school. Further she received her associate's degree in Accounting from Parkland College in Champaign, Illinois. She went to work for the city of Urbana, and was a bookkeeper at Community Christian School in Savoy, Illinois and Judah Christian High School in Champaign. After moving to San Antonio, Texas she received her

paralegal certification and opened her own business, Personal Management Team. Linda had a lifelong love of dance. Bill and Linda were married on June 3rd 1967 in Bushnell, IL at the age of 20 and 17, respectively. They adopted their son Kevin in 1971 and lived in Rantoul, IL. Later the family moved to Urbana, IL. After moving to San Antonio, Bill retired and Linda started a consulting business. They enjoyed Sunday trips in Bill's Corvette and frequenting car shows. Bill and Linda are survived by their son Kevin and their grandson Gavin.
