



## Lloyd R. Brown

Lloyd Rentz Brown was born at home on April 20, 1925 in Dolores Colorado and died on February 9, 2015 at the age of 89. He was preceded in death by his parents Roe Arthur Brown and Zula E. Ince, his brothers Douglas and Thurston, his son Terry Eugene Brown and his beloved wife Betty Jo Brown. Lloyd is survived by his daughters Nancy Brown McDougall Mike of Kingsland, TX, Rose Brown Goodall Jerry of Lewis, Colorado and son Cristy Switzer of Cortez, Colorado. He then spent ten years raising his grandson Terry Eugene Brown, Jr. Lloyd lived independently until the last few months of his life. He lived a life of service to his country and his family. Lloyd was a gentle man who was a non-judgmental listener, and who showed us the meaning of sacrificial love and respect. He was a leader who was full of integrity and well respected by his family and co-workers, who so faithfully supported our Dad. We will miss his beautiful smile and quick wit.
