Logan A. Hipp, Jr., was born on July 4, 1924 in Memphis, Tenn. and passed away on January 29, 2007. He was a great father, a wonderful husband to wife, Louise B. Hipp for 53 years and the nicest businessman to ever work with. He graduated from Memphis State University in 1950, earned a law degree from Vanderbilt University in 1952 and a Doctor of Jurisprudence in 1969. Logan worked for the U.S.F. and G. Insurance Co. for 32 years, before retiring as branch manager in 1991. He earned numerous awards and achievements in the business community and was highly respected and loved. Logan served active duty U.S. Marine Corps in WWII and was a little league coach and scoutmaster for many years. He also served as deacon at San Pedro Presbyterian Church. He was preceded in death by his mother, Flora Kelley; father, "Shifty" Logan Sr.; daughter, Elizabeth Braswell Hipp Wiechmann.
