Loren Yunes Melo, 50, went to be with the Lord on Monday, September 19, 2022. She was born on September 18, 1972, in Mexico City. She is survived by her adoring husband, Carlos Melo, her three loving sons, Carlos Salim (19), Alek Emiliano (17), Lorenzo Jamil (14), and her Chocolate Lab, Max. She is also survived by her sister Anel Yunes Silva, her husband Luis Silva, and daughters Alexa and Mia; and, her brother George Yunes, his wife Andrea Yunes, daughter Tarah, and son Alexander. She was so proud of her children, and all of her nieces and nephews and their accomplishments.

She was preceded in death by her parents Jorge and Georgianna (Mery) Yunes, along with her brother Juan Carlos Yunes, who together passed 37 years ago, to the day, on September 19, 1985, due to an earthquake in Mexico City.

When her children were young and attended Holy Spirit Catholic School, she happily served as a volunteer and later a classroom aide for second grade. As her boys got older, she became a dedicated and well-known team parent at both Central Catholic and Tom C. Clark High schools.

Loren relished spending quality time with her large, close-knit family, and she prioritized this above all else. She was an extremely generous person, evidenced by her decision to be an organ donor. Simple things made her very happy; a clean house, roses, warm banana bread. She loved music and dancing, Snoopy, and holding babies. She loved going to the beach and putting her feet in the water. She enjoyed watching game shows such as the Price is Right, Family Feud, and Wheel of Fortune. She loved her Lebanese heritage and she was a phenomenal cook. Most of all, she loved to laugh, and we loved to laugh with her.

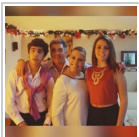
