



## Louis A. Castano Jr.

May 16, 1941 - June 30, 2022

Surrounded in love by his family and beloved wife, Louis Angelini Castaño Jr., age 81, passed away peacefully on Thursday, June 30, 2022. Born May 16, 1941, in San Antonio, Texas to Luis Castaño and Maria De La Luz Angelini Castaño both of Texas, Louis was a man of devout faith and family.

Born and raised in the Catholic Church, Louis' faith became a focus in his life and served as his life-long anchor, guiding his actions, and navigating his decisions. His unwavering faith was apparent to anyone who was lucky enough to know him.

Louis graduated from Fox Tech High School and went on to work at Kelly Air Force Base for 35 years. He started in the Plating shop and had various career moves that ultimately lead him to Water Treatment facility, as an Environmental Water Treatment Specialist.

Louis was a founding member of the Knights of Columbus Council 8158, the first council of the Resurrection of the Lord Catholic Church. He was proud to be a founding partner of an organization focused on serving others, and could always be found working the grill as the BBQ master. Those who met him never questioned how Louis felt about them. He saw the good in everyone he met.

Louis met the love of his life, Alice Martinez Castaño at the young age of 18. For him there was never any one else. They married at Our Lady of Perpetual Help in 1963, he was 21 and Alice was 19. They were married 59 years in October. Together they raised two daughters, Judith M. Castaño and Katherine A. Parra and one son, George A. Castaño.

Nothing meant more to Louis than providing and caring for his family. Working second shift and coming home to help with the children was standard for him. His three children and six grandchildren adored him. He cherished each of them and always told them so. Everyone who knew Louis knew where they stood with him and were sure of his love, always. The legacy of his name, Castaño, was of utmost importance to Louis, and the legacy he leaves within his children and grandchildren is apparent in their long eyelashes, love of BBQ, strong Catholic faith, and connection to family.

As father and Popo, Louis loved to create with his hands and his works of art are cherished by those who received them. If it was broken, he could fix it, if it needed to be drawn, he could draw it, and if there was a treasure to be found at the Dollar Tree Store, he would create the most thoughtful treasure.
