



Louis Wayne Masters

May 23, 1932 - June 1, 2022

Louis Wayne Masters of Seguin, formerly of San Antonio rejoined his wife and daughter with the lord on June 1, 2022, at the age of 90. Louis was born May 23, 1932, in Bentonville, Arkansas and was the ninth of thirteen children born to Pat Cleburne Masters and Maude Anderson Masters.

Louis was raised in Castroville, TX with his family and was the leading rebel of his brothers and sisters. In his youth he danced his way around the hill country with his sisters that made him a lifelong lover of music and two-stepping. It was at one of these dances, he met his wife of 56 years, Mary Frances Long Masters. They married a few years later and proceeded to raise their 3 children (Ronda, Roxanne and David) at their home in San Antonio. Louis was a stonemason and bricklayer all his life, achieving his fifty-year pin in 2005. In 1981, Louis and Mary Frances moved to Castle Rock, Colorado to work on a special job to build some of the large homes and mansions that still grace those mountains. Louis always wanted to open a burger stand in Colorado, but instead, he and Mary Frances decided to return to San Antonio in 1984.

Throughout his life, Louis loved causing havoc and tore up dance floors and honky tonks whenever he could. In his early years he raced cars, worked horses and cattle on the Briggs and YO ranches. He was a good “shade tree” mechanic as well. Louis was active for many years on various trail rides and

riding clubs and always ending up riding through downtown in the parade associated with the San Antonio Stock Show and Rodeo. If it was early in the morning and you wanted to find Louis, just head out to the lake or the river as he loved to fish. He taught his kids to fish, and even in his 80s took great pride in teaching his grandson to fish on his boat at Calaveras Lake. Louis loved to barbeque and considered himself a "Master of Brisket".

Louis was preceded in death by his wife of 56 years, Mary Francis and his daughter Roxanne, his parents, Pat C. and Maude Masters, brothers Harold, Earl, Bobby, Charles, Pete, and Donnie Masters and sisters Eileen Lowther, Francis Kramer, Geraldine (Jerry) Eardley, and Eula Giffert.

He is survived by his daughter Ronda Gale Hammons (Mark), son David Wayne, grandson Dylan, 4 step grandchildren, 8 step great grandchildren, sister Evelyn Dittlinger, brother Jimmy (Darla), sister-in-law Dorothy Masters, numerous nephews, nieces, and many friends.

Visitation will be on Saturday, June 11th, 2022 from 11:30 am to 1:00 pm at Mission Park South Funeral Chapel. Funeral service will be on Saturday, June 11th, 2022 at 1:00 pm with interment immediately following.
