



## Louise Hrcir

November 12, 1921 - August 7, 2018

Louise Julia Rose Hrcir (née Caninenberg), age 96, peacefully died in her sleep on August 7, 2018, in Pearland, Texas.

Louise is survived by her daughter, Diane Trube, of Pearland, Texas; her granddaughters, Julie Victory and Lori Victory, of Houston, Texas; her sisters, Doris Hardi, of Round Rock, Texas and LaVerne Haag, of Austin, Texas; and her son, Allen Hrcir, of Los Angeles, California. She was preceded in death by her parents; husband, Manuel Hrcir; sisters, Anita Wolfe and Ruby Abshier; brother, Vernon Caninenberg; and son-in-law Brant Trube.

Louise was born on November 12, 1921 in Thrall, Texas, to parents Friedrich "Fritz" Caninenberg and Clara Marie Kreig. She was engaged to marry Tech-Sgt. Richard Meiske of Taylor, Texas, who was killed in a plane crash during World War II. She was working at Southwestern Bell Telephone Company as a telephone operator when a tall, Czech man swept her off her feet. She married Manuel Hrcir on June 20, 1950 and the couple raised their two children in San Antonio, Texas.

Louise was an excellent seamstress who was still altering her clothes at 94 years old. She also spent many hours in her rose garden cultivating her favorite color roses: pink and purple. She enjoyed cooking and baking for her family and polka dancing with her husband. She was a loving and devoted mother and grandmother who will be dearly missed.

A visitation is scheduled for 10:30am on August 14, 2018, at Holy Cross Cemetery & Mausoleum in San Antonio, Texas with a service to immediately
