Lucille Elaine Hawks Shean, age 94, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother passed away after prolonged illness on October 22, 2012. Lucille was born on February 17, 1918, in Omaha Nebraska, and graduated from North High School in Omaha in 1935. On August 31, 1940, she married Col. John P. Shean and became a career military wife, mother and homemaker. They lived abroad in Greece, Turkey, Germany, and various bases in the United States. Lucille was a member of St Andrews Presbyterian Church and The Presbyterian Women; the Greater San Antonio Quilt Guild founding member; a member of the San Antonio Needlework Guild; the Girl Scouts of America and World Association of Girl Scouts; the American Camping Association; the Officer's Wives Club; and she was a 25 year docent at the Institute of Texan Cultures. She was a gifted quilter, needlework enthusiast, and talented seamstress, especially remembered for her unique handmade vests. Also a creative gardener, Lucille enjoyed entertaining and learned to cook many foreign cuisines while living abroad. Lucille is preceded in death by her husband John P. Shean, youngest daughter Karen Lucille Carter, and grandson Craig Carter. She is survived by daughters Phyllis Edwards, Linda Reed, Nadine McGuire and husband Bill McGuire; 10 grandchildren, 10 great grandchildren, and 3 great-great grandchildren.
