On Tuesday, March 31, 2020, Lucy Trcka Bishop, loving wife and mother of four passed away peacefully in her sleep at her residence.

Lucy was born on April 17, 1926 to Rosalie and Michael Trcka in Nada, Texas. Valedictorian of her high school class in Ganado, Texas she moved to San Antonio after graduation and began working in accounting at Kelly AFB. Lucy was lucky to live next door to a handsome young Marine who turned out to be the love of her life. Lucy and Robert (Bob) Bishop were married on October 4, 1950. They raised two daughters, Joni and Terri, and two sons, Rob and Greg. Bob passed away 23 years ago in 1997.

Even when Lucy had four small children at home, she still had enough energy to participate in an adult volleyball league. Every church or family picnic included volleyball and Lucy and Bob were out there playing. Lucy was intelligent and a talented athlete. She liked to tell us stories about her horseback riding skills learned on her family's farm.

Lucy was a devout and dedicated parishioner at St. Francis of Assisi. All her life, she served the church through various committees, also helping to establish three new parishes in San Antonio. Lucy accumulated many lifelong friends at each parish. Her Bunco group played together for over 50 years. Lucy loved music and sang in the church choir every Sunday for over 60 years. Her beautiful alto voice warranted a few solos and many compliments. Her love of music and singing carried over into dancing. Bob and Lucy loved to dance together and never missed a chance to dance. Lucy continued

dancing at every wedding she attended. Most memorable was her dance with grandson Jacob at his wedding. Lucy had to use a walker then, but that didn't stop her! She kept dancing at her assisted living community for as long as she could.

After her children were grown, Lucy's developed a passion for oil painting that led to the creation of many beautiful landscapes. Texas landscapes were a favorite. She graciously gifted many of these paintings. Her detailed bluebonnet fields and country roads were most popular. She never sold a painting, but her family thinks she could have been quite famous for her art. With her infectious smile, determined spirit, intelligence, sense of humor, kindness, and immense talent, Lucy made quite an impression in her life. She will remain forever in our hearts. We take great comfort knowing she is dancing with her sweetheart Bob again.

Lucy is survived by three children, Joni (Rick) Beal, Terri (Mac) Perry and Greg (Nanette) Bishop, She was the proud grandmother of Daniel (Melinda) Perry, Jacob (Ali) Perry, Sarah (Garrett) Klaproth, Brandon (Whitney) Beal, Stephanie (Scott) Mussell, step-grandsons Layne (Genia) Beal, and Ryan Beal and great-grandmother of 7. She is also survived by many nieces and nephews and sister-in-law Zena Trcka.
