October 9, 1937 - December 13, 2020

Luis Huizar, Sr. was born in San Antonio, Texas on October 9, 1937 and went to be with the Lord on December 13, 2020 at the age of 83. He was a direct descendant of Don Pedro Huizar, sculptor of the "Rose Window" at San Jose Mission. He served proudly in the US Army and was Honorably Discharged. He met his wife, Andrea, shortly after and was happily married for 57 years. He was also a proud graduate of Southwest Texas State University and retired as a civil service employee from Kelly Air Force Base.

He is preceded in death by his beloved wife, Andrea S. 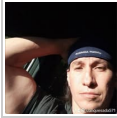
