He married his beloved sweetheart Maria Guzman in 1954 and built a beautiful life and family in San Antonio, Texas. He was known for being a Hero, but we knew him for his kind heart and candid humor. He was our Grandpa Lupe.

He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Maria Rodriguez and their only son: Daniel Rodriguez & his wife Letty Rodriguez; his three granddaughters, Ann Rodriguez, Katheryn Rodriguez, and Andrea Rodriguez; his two great-granddaughters Leia and Penelope. His brother, Daniel and sister Anita.
