It was a difficult business and they eventually decided it would be more satisfying to raise children than chickens since they already had five of their own. They started Suburban Child Care/Happy Acres Day Camp in 1963 and over the years all five children helped in that venture. They retired in January of 1984 and the school lives on under Terry and Barney's care. Mom loved

camping on the beach in Port Aransas, hiking in the mountains, and spending time at their place on Lake Dunlap. She especially loved their condo in Ruidoso, NM where she enjoyed watching the hummingbirds battle and shopping in the little town. Her knowledge regarding wildflowers, trees, and birds was amazing. When she was able, mom planned all of our family gatherings with Christmas being her favorite. No one could decorate like she could! All of these things she greatly enjoyed sharing with family and friends. We will miss her dearly, but we will always be grateful for the wonderful memories. Not long after moving to Oakland Estates they helped to found Oxford United Methodist Church and were active members throughout the years.
