Madelyn Virginia Sassman, 97, went to be with the Lord on June 3, 2020. She was born on September 28, 1922 on a farm in Thorndale, Texas to Arthur J. Gregory and Martha McKay Gregory.

Madelyn first worked as a Western Union telegraph operator in the 1940's, then married and moved to San Antonio where she raised her family. She retired from Medical Bureau Associates in 1985.

She was a charter member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church and was a faithful follower of Christ. She told everyone she met about Jesus, read scripture daily, and was lovingly known as a prayer warrior.

Madelyn spent her last years in the Westover Hills nursing home where she continued to be an encouragement and joy to others. She was grateful to the staff, nurses, and other caregivers that took such good care of her during her time at the nursing home.

Madelyn had 11 brothers and sisters who have all preceded her in death along with her parents.
