



## Mae Baker Kelly

January 5, 1938 - August 22, 2023

Mae Baker Kelly of San Antonio, Texas, passed away peacefully at home in the early hours of Tuesday, August 22nd, 2023 at the age of 85 years. Mae was born Mae Agnes Baker in Goose Creek, Texas on January 5th 1938 to Rex J. Baker and Eva Mae Copland Baker. After growing up in La Port, Texas, she attended Southwest Texas Teachers College, graduating in May of 1960 with a Bachelor's of Science in Home Economics and a Teaching Certificate. While teaching at Poth High School, in South Texas, she met the love of her life, Theodore (Ted) Chilton Kelly Sr. They were married in December of 1962.

She was preceded by her husband, Ted Sr. by over 30 years. Survivors include her sister, Barbara Ann Warnock, Theodore (Ted) Chilton Kelly II, her son, Jennifer D. Kelly, her daughter-in-law, and three grandchildren: Bethany Nicole Yahkanich, Theodore (Ted) Chilton Kelly III, and Connor Ryan Kelly.

Mae was a long standing and active member of St. Stephens Episcopal Church, The Daughters of the King, The Harp and Shamrock Society of Texas, The Beethoven Maennerchor Concert Band, and a founding member emeritus of the Kelly Singers.

A viewing will be held at Mission Park Funeral Chapels South at 1700 SE Military Drive in San Antonio, Texas on Wednesday, September 6th from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m.. A full Episcopal Service will be held the following morning,

Thursday, September 7th at 9:30 a.m., with a graveside internment ceremony shortly thereafter.

A reception will also be held after the ceremony at Brookhill Baptist Church Parrish Hall at 631 Utopia Ln. San Antonio, TX 78223.
