



## Maige M. Rodriguez

July 9, 1929 - August 2, 2012

Maige M. Rodriguez was born in Luling, Texas on July 9, 1929 and died on August 2, 2012. He was preceded in death by his wife Yolanda, his parents Sabino and Guadalupe, three brothers: Jesse, Joe and Jaime; three sisters: Lupita, Mary Ayala, and Stella Gomez. After graduation from Luling High School he enlisted in the Air Force. In May 1953 he was designated a Distinguished Graduate and commissioned a Second Lieutenant.
