Lynn Paul Bishop, age 88, passed into eternal life on November 13, 2010 at his home in San Antonio, TX. He retired as a Major from the US Air Force. Paul served during WWII as a P-51 fighter pilot and was the recipient of the Purple Heart and the Distinguished Flying Cross. Following his military service, Paul continued his career at Southwestern Bell, retiring after 35 years. Paul was an avid golfer, gardener, fisherman and oil painter. He is survived by his wife of 66 years, Jo Bishop of San Antonio, TX, a son, Gary Bishop and wife Donna of Springtown, TX, a daughter, Paula Kay Bishop of Corpus Christi, TX, 4 grandchildren, 9 great-grandchildren and a step great-grandson. He was preceded in death by his parents, Lemie and Maude Bishop and a brother, Glen Bishop.
