Major Myron B. "Andy" Andricks, USAF Ret., went to be with the Lord on December 26, 2009 in San Antonio. He was born on April 18, 1922 in San Antonio to Erwin Andricks and Kate Mann. Myron entered the service in 1938 at the age of 16. He went thru cadet training in 1942 and went to the war in Europe to fly the B-17 Flying Fortress as a bombardier navigator. After that he flew the B-36 Bomber and was in the first formation to fly over Washington, D.C. Myron earned the Purple Heart Cluster, the Distinguished Flying Cross, the Presidential Unit Citation, Air Medal, Pre-Pearl Harbor Medal and the Asiatic-Pacific Campaign. After his military career, Myron was involved in the car & truck business for 30 years and spent his leisure time hunting and fishing. He was preceded in death by his parents; and his beloved daughter, Lynette Andricks. Myron is survived by his loving wife of 62 years; and close family friends, Ruth and Tom Cole.
