Manuel C. Barrera, Jr. went to be with the Lord on January 11, 2022 at the age of 79. He was born on September 8, 1942 in Elmendorf, Texas to Manuel V. Barrera and Juanita Casias Barrera. He is preceded in death by his parents, his sisters Carolina Moreno and Janie Martinez, and brother Simon C. Barrera. Manuel is survived by his loving wife of 48 years Guadalupe G.
