October 4, 1935 - February 6, 2005

Margaret H. “Peggy” Jackman died Sunday, February 6, 2005 at age 69. She was born on October 4, 1935 to William F. and Marion R. Halstead in Ramsey, New Jersey. After graduation from Ramsey High School she attended Allegheny College. She moved to San Antonio in 1962 and began a career in insurance, working for American General and USAA in both personal and commercial lines. She left the industry and pursued a lifelong dream of studying art and received a BFA with a concentration in Painting in 1987 from UT San Antonio. Her work has been shown in 7 states and 2 foreign countries. Peggy taught painting for Adult Education Classes and later worked for WorldCom. Being a cancer survivor, she was an active member of the Ralph Kay Chapter of the United Ostomy Association, and was a driver for the American Cancer Society’s Road to Recovery. She was a supporter of the arts, an avid reader, and an animal lover. She also enjoyed traveling and spending time with her family and friends.

She is survived by her sister, Marion Grace Durholz, sons William Joseph Jackman and wife Dorothy, Dr. Donald Alan Jackman and wife Susan Ivins, Robert Corrin Jackman and wife Sheila, daughter, Karen Jackman Cinnamon and husband David, 9 grandchildren, 3 nieces, 1 nephew, and a host of friends.
