Beloved wife, mother and grandmother, Margaret Dorothy Keller, entered eternal rest with her Lord on January 9, 2009. She was born in St. Louis, Missouri on February 23, 1919, received registered nurses training from St. John's Hospital and relocated to San Antonio following the end of World War II. She was married to Andrew S. Keller for over 50 years before his death in 1997. Both Andrew and Margaret were long time parishioners at St. Gregory's Catholic Church in San Antonio. Margaret taught elementary classes at St. Mary Magdalen Catholic School in the early 1960's then resumed her nursing career with the Nix Memorial Hospital later that decade. She is survived by her sons Gerald Charlene of Carrollton, Texas, David Diane of San Antonio, Richard Melody of Santo, Texas and Michael Keller of San Antonio and numerous grand and great-grand children.
