MARGARET JEAN COMERFORD MAC FADDEN LEFT HER EARTHLY HOME FOR HER HEAVENLY HOME ON FEBRUARY 17, 2010. SHE HAS GONE TO JOIN HER HUSBAND SCOTTY AND HER DAUGHTER JACKIE. SHE LEAVES HER SON JAMES K. MAC FADDEN, HER DAUGHTER NANCY COCHRAN GERALD, GRANDDAUGHTER KELLY MELSON, GRANDSON BLAINE SUTTON, SON-IN-LAW BOROMANARD EK-HOUL MARY, AND SEVERAL NIECES, NEPHEWS AND DEVOTED FRIENDS. JEAN WAS BORN JANUARY 22, 1921 IN ASHTABULA, OHIO. SHE GRADUATED FROM ASHTABULA HARBOR HIGH AND ATTENDED KENT STATE UNIVERSITY. JEAN WAS MARRIED TO SCOTTY FOR 48 YEARS AND THEY HAD THREE CHILDREN. SHE RETIRED FROM THE USAF SECURITY SERVICE IN 1981 AND BECAME VERY ACTIVE IN CIVIC AFFAIRS. SHE HELPED CREATE AND WAS THE FIRST DIRECTOR OF THE JEFFERSON OUTREACH FOR OLDER PEOPLE. FOR ALMOST SIX YEARS THIS WAS THE INSPIRATION OF HER LIFE, HELPING THE ELDERLY TO STAY IN THEIR HOMES AS LONG AS POSSIBLE. THIS ORGANIZATION IS STILL ACTIVE TODAY TAKING MEALS TO THE HOME-BOUND AND PROVIDING TRANSPORTATION TO MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS FOR THOSE WHO HAVE NO OTHER MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION. JEAN SERVED AS ELDER IN GRACE

PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH WHERE SHE WAS A MEMBER FROM 1953 – 2001. SHE WAS CURRENTLY A MEMBER OF OAK HILLS PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH. SHE ALSO SERVED AS A DIRECTOR OF THE JEFFERSON NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION, DIRECTOR OF THE SAN ANTONIO URBAN MINISTRIES, ADVISORY DIRECTOR OF THE VIA BOARD FOR THE DISABLED, DIRECTOR OF THE SAN ANTONIO GUARDIANSHIP BOARD AND SHE HELPED ORGANIZE A PROGRAM FOR AT-RISK YOUTH IN THE JEFFERSON VILLAGE AREA CALLED "YOUTH DROP-IN".
