Margaret was already heavily involved at EC but taking this position was the start of her becoming the Queen Bee. Margaret became the President of the Spirit of EC Booster Club and was a huge supporter of the Honeybee Varsity Dance Team & Golden Star Drill Team. Margaret supported all students, sports, clubs and organizations at ECHS, Margaret was the #1 Hornet fan. Margaret moved to the position of Principal's Secretary and then to the position of Executive Assistant to the Superintendent. It was said by many that she ran ECHS and then that she ran ECISD, she truly was the Queen Bee of EC. But Margaret's favorite title of Grammy was given to her in 2011 with the birth of her first granddaughter Scarlett with a second granddaughter Sienna arriving in 2015. Margaret loved her granddaughters will all her heart. They were her world. She loved to spoil them with clothes, treats, movies and special trips to the Zoo. Margaret loved to plan big parties and events, she loved to craft and add sparkle and bling to everything.

Margaret was always full of joy and life and was warm and kind to everyone. The Queen Bee touched many lives and we are all honored that we had the opportunity to know and love her.
