July 16, 1930 - August 1, 2017

MARIA DEL CARMEN ROSA (“CARMELITITA”), went to the Lord’s presence on August 1st, 2017 at 87 years old in San Antonio, Texas. She was born in the picturesque town of Xilitla, San Luis Potosi, Mexico on July 16, 1930; daughter of Narciso Pulido and Petra Medina, she was raised by her grandmother, Serafina Salinas; she married Ricardo Q. Rosa-González on October 30, 1954. Carmelita lived in her hometown all her childhood and during her youth in San Luis Potosí, where she studied to become a Bilingual Secretary at the “Instituto Hispano Inglés” (Hispanic English Institute), a Catholic School run by the Congregation of the Charity Sisters of the Incarnate Word. Most probably, because of her education in this school, Carmelita had excellent spelling and grammar both in English and Spanish; she was a very methodic, organized and a hard working woman.

She was an entrepreneur and together with her husband Ricardo had several small businesses; including a store where they sold toasted coffee, a small groceries store where you could find the finest wine and cheese in Xilitla. Carmelita was also an English teacher in the town school and for many years she was known as an excellent baker, since she would prepare delicious desserts and cakes for the weddings in town.

For many years, Carmelita actively participated in the Movimiento de Cursillos de Cristiandad (Christianity Training Courses), an evangelization movement

from the Catholic Church.

Carmelita and Ricardo were happy to celebrate their 63rd anniversary surrounded by their family.

Carmelita was very loved by her lifelong girlfriends. She was a woman of great faith, she had love and kindness for everyone, she was an excellent daughter, sister, wife and above all an excellent mother. She enjoyed with all her heart having her family together, her children were her greatest treasure.

She is survived by her husband, Ricardo Rosa González, her children, Rosa María Rosa, María del Carmen Escamilla, Martha Patricia McDonald, Flor de María Rosa and Alejandro de Jesús Rosa. Her grandchildren Juan Miguel Hernández, Ricardo Hernández, Gracia Carolina Rivera-Rosa, Joseph Escamilla, Valencia McDonald, Nathan McDonald, Martin Rosa, Alberto Rosa and Lunita Rosa. Her great-grandchildren Andrea Hernández, Miguel Ángel Hernández, Diego Rivera and Samuelito Rivera, and her brothers Carlos Pulido, Javier Pulido, Ruben Pulido and Efrain Pulido.
