Marian Alita Tuseth King, age 91 passed into Glory October 17, 2013. She is survived by her children Reinette Alecozay and Bradley Craig King, both of San Antonio. Marian taught music for over 50 years including organ, piano, accordion, vibra harp and voice. She lived in Lawton Oklahoma from 1961-1971. While there, she served as secretary at St Paul's United Methodist Church, taught music and opened her own business, The Needle Nook where she taught knitting, crocheting and other needlework. Since moving to San Antonio with her children in 1971, she taught organ and piano, served as secretary of Central Christian Church, worked as secretary at Alamo Cement,

Person to Person, a welcome service company and served in several capacities at Region 20 Educational Service Center. With a heart of community service, she served as secretary of the El Dorado Homes Association under four presidents. A people person, her witty sense of humor entertained all. She is loved and cherished by many friends and family members. She loved God with all her heart, soul, mind and strength and loved her neighbor as herself.
