



Marie (Statkiewicz) Holt

February 18, 1935 - April 13, 2017

Marie (Statkiewicz) Holt was born on February 18, 1935 in Shenandoah, Pennsylvania. She went to be with the Lord at 3:08 PM on April 13, 2017.

She graduated from Shenandoah High School in May of 1953. She subsequently attended Temple University School of Nursing and Northeastern Hospital in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Upon graduation in 1956, she was commissioned as an ensign in the United States Navy as a Navy Nurse. Her first duty station was in Oakland at the local navy base hospital. She was a nurse in the Operating Room there. She completed her service (over three years) and married a young naval aviator, Tim Holt, in 1959. They were married in a civil ceremony in Reno, Nevada and again aboard the USS Hancock. During their 52 years of marriage Marie and Tim had two children, Patty and Mark. As is often the case in the military, they moved around the country from California to Florida to Georgia and eventually to Kingsville, Texas, where Marie opened up a needlecraft shop called "Needle Craft Nook". When Tim retired in 1979, they moved to San Antonio. During retirement, Marie served others while volunteering at Lackland Air Force Base. The majority of her time was spent in the Diabetes and Endocrinology department, where she greeted patients and coordinated family visits with staff and physicians. She moved to Rosemont Assisted Living facility in 2013 and resided there until her death on April 13, 2017.

She leaves behind her sister, (Dorothy Franks), brother, (Arnold Statkiewicz), Daughter and Son In Law, (Patty (Holt) and Steve Tillotson), Son and Daughter in Law, (Mark and Donis Holt), six grandchildren, (Mallory Metcalf and her husband Mark, Andrew Tillotson and his wife Leslie, Patrick Tillotson, Lauren Holt, Nicholas Holt and Gabrielle Pryor), and four great grandchildren, (Silas and Nolan Holt and Dorothy and Samuel Tillotson).
