Marie C. Johnson (née Montemayor) was a beloved wife, mother, grandmother, and community advocate whose life reflected love, strength, and deep-rooted values. Born to Jesus and Rafaela Montemayor, she was preceded in death by her husband, Eugene G. Johnson, and brothers Jesus, Ray, Eddie, and Herbie.
