Marion L. Sansone, 105, died peacefully on May 30, 2022 in residence at Gracious Living Personal Home Care in Boerne, Texas. She was born on July 25, 1916 in Dunlo, Pennsylvania to her parents, Sicilian immigrants, Cosimo Cosimano and Rose Cosimano (San Fillipe). She married her husband, Rocco, in 1940. Marion was a teenager during the Great Depression. At the age of 16, she moved to New Jersey to work as a waitress. She loved her job and the opportunity to socialize with her customers. Serving many others customers who still have memories of her enthusiasm and smile. Finally, after serving food with a smile for over 75 years she retired in 2010 at the age of 94.
