Mark David Trevino was born to Victor and Marie Trevino on May 8, 1967 and died in New York on Oct. 13, 2006. After receiving a degree in Music Education from Baylor University, Mark dedicated his life to music administration in Texas, Virginia, Washington, and New York.
